BRIDGE TO RN NURSING PROGRAM

A program that prepares graduates to provide direct care as a registered nurse in acute, long term, ambulatory, and community oriented settings. The program prepares the nurse to participate in health promotion and maintenance of activities for the individuals in the context of a family and community. Upon program completion, the Associate degree nursing graduate is eligible to take the NCLEX examination for licensure as a registered nurse. Sample of reported job titles (from O*Net online)

- Utilize critical thinking to plan implemented and manage care in a safe, effective environment for clients
- Relate principles from the conceptual framework to assist clients in adapting to change along the health-illness continuum throughout the lifespan
- Coordinate and delegate holistic client care in a variety of health care settings while adhering to the RN's scope of practice.
